About Alpha Aviation Academy



- Launched in 2008, Alpha Aviation Academy UAE is Located at Sharjah International Airport
- Managed by Air Arabia, AAA is currently the largest Multi-crew Pilot License (MPL) facility in the Region
- Over 80 Cadets already graduated and flying the Airbus A320 with Air Arabia
- 130 Cadets currently under training



About Air Arabia



- Air Arabia is the Middle East and North Africa's first and largest Low Cost Carrier
- ABY flies to more than 86 destinations across Middle East, North Africa, Asia and Europe
- Operates one Aircraft type, the Airbus A320
- Current fleet consists of 34 new Aircrafts with an existing order for 44 more



About MPL – the beginning



- Traditional route to become a Comercial Pilot was obtaining a Comercial Pilot License and Instrument Rating (CPL/IR)
- CPL/IR was designed in an era where newly qualified commercial pilots were most likely to spend a number of years flying slower, turbo propeller aircraft before they ever had the opportunity to fly jet aircraft
- Not only was this a lengthy process, the format of this training, developed shortly after the Second World War, remained unchanged for over 25 Years



About MPL – the confirmation



 Today it is recognized that the entry level for newly-qualified airline pilots is a co-pilot on the world's most modern, highly sophisticated and complex jet aircraft

This led to the birth of the MPL



The Multi-Crew Pilot License (MPL)



- Fully supported and promoted by ICAO
- Increasing, being adopted and embraced by Civil Aviation Authorities and Airlines around the World
- ICAO recognize that MPL training is airline relevant, using the latest methodology, the most technically advanced aircraft simulators and experienced airline training instructors
- MPL training incorporates Threat and Error Management (TEM) into the entire training program.
- MPL is a competency based training program that ensures the students reach the required skills and behaviors before they can progress to next level of training




- Direct entry to Co-Pilot

- AAA/ABY MPL program consists on:
 - 18 Months of training
 - 845h Ground School
 - 70h real flight time
 - 219h Simulator Training
 - 1500h flying A320

- Completed in Europe
- 70 Hours single engine piston
- Solo flight
- Night Flight
- Basic Instruments Flight
- Recovering from unusual attitudes
- Modern and advanced Aircrafts





Basic Flying Phase

- 72h Multi-engine jet Advanced Simulator
- Crew Resource Management (CRM)
- Threat and Error Management (TEM)
- Advanced instrument flying
- Contains Multi Crew Cooperation Course (MCC)





Intermediate Flying Phase

- 39h MFTD + 48h Full Flight Simulator
- Preparing Cadets for the Airbus A320
- Airbus A320 Systems
- FMS
- ECAM
- Airline Standard Operating Procedures (SOP)
- Ground Operations Scenarios







Advanced Flying Phase

- 60h on Full Flight Simulator
- Training the students to fly the Airbus A320 (Type Rating)
- Cockpit identical to Aircrafts in the Fleet
- Experience and practice full range of emergency situations
- Abnormal procedures
- Recovery maneuvers
- License Skill test at the end of the Phase





- Airbus A320 Base Training
 - Final Stage of the Training
 - 9 Take-offs and Landings with Real Airplane
